Rather than looking up each drug and changing to its generic form, you can

- In the Repeat MedicationqPanel Highlight the medications you wish to change to generic, and right click your mouse.
- You can choose whether to change the entire panel of repeats, or you can choose to only highlight the medications you wish to change.
- When you Rt click your mouse, you will get an *DPTIONq* menu as shown in **figure.2**
- Simply choose the item 'change to generic'
- This automatically changes your selection to **Generic** format.
