## **FAMILY CIRCLES**

This is a method of linking members of the same family


It is an alternative to using the "family number" system – it is an option.


You can convert your existing family numbers to family circles from within the HCR or en masse.

Now you view a new "family tab" by clicking the main menu item "view"  $\rightarrow$  analysis grids  $\rightarrow$  family





Right click anywhere in the family circle tab and click "add member" to search for a patient to add to the family circle


Alternatively right click and choose "check proposals". Health one makes an attempt to

display possible family members, based on names and address and family numbers.

Note: Patient can be part of multiple family circles.

You end up with a list of patients in the family tab that belong to this family



- You can define a family circle from the main Patient selector by choosing several patients and right clicking → define family circle
- Billing -This list of family members is used now for the billing debtor "family"
- You can also define a family circle from the billing module.
- You can open another patient of the family by double clicking on any member.
- You can right click on any member to define the type of relationship between family members (father, son, daughter, ...) This information is saved in the administrative transaction.

The same dialog can be used to define a <u>contact person</u> (neighbour, friend etc.) This person may or may not be a member of the family circle.

This person may not even be in the Health one list of patients



## You can enter the details of the contact person in two ways:

1. Enter the data manually or

2. Pick up a patient file by clicking the picture.

If linked to a patient, the administrative data is extracted from the linked patient file and not duplicated.

## Family History

You can add the family history of an existing family member to another family member. In the Basic Medical transaction, you add the item "family history". This item has a new icon on the top right.
