Here is a summary of the changes since the release version 1837

1. Pregnancy
 - a) Add “vaccine” item to antenatal form
 - b) Rename labels “infant feeding” and “birth weight”
 - c) Add number of days to duration except in the pregnancy grid
 - d) Add “design” button to edit Pregnancy fast reports
 - e) Foetal presentation – remove “bregmatic”
 - f) Printing the pregnancy grid in referral (1844 -Maternity_Referral.frf)

 - g) We now take care of still births (delivery new term) → flag the pregnancy grid.
 - h) Bug fixed where the mat number and hospital get deleted if you reedit the Mediform

2. Drug information
 - a) Now allow larger amount of text in the “personal information” tab {contained in IPUDrugPrivate.mdb
 - b) NOAC form (Fast report) updated 2015
3. Kardex – we can now extract and print the date first prescribed

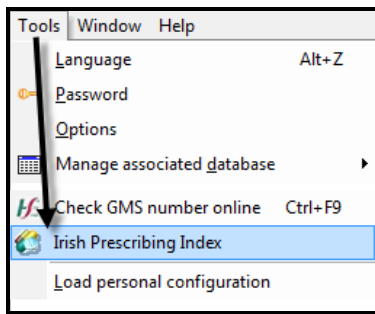
4. Medical Information
 - a) New menu item in “manage associated databases” icon → “Medical information” → displays a list of H1 item contents that have clinical info and allows to view any one
 - b) As a when importing from an xml file with several note.

5. VPN Printing – Easier method of printing to remote printers –Printer setup →

6. Under 6s – Version 7.5.1.1852
 - a) Billing module → list view to get amount earned by age group in a period
 - b) Built in analyses → cube anal → patients Cube [Age/Sex/Class..] displays numbers of patients by age and by GMS status (improved) and by “Doctor in Charge”
 - c) Cube anal “Consultation rates for patients seen” → now displays
Age/GMS – Transaction count/patient count/Consultation rate X age/GMS status/user

7. Irish Pharmaceutical Index export – New function to export your prescriptions anonymously to the IPI for analysis and feedback and comparison with other prescribers. Very similar to iPCRN export. You can opt in or out of this.

8. PCSA export – Primary Care Surgical Association. Based on data entry by minor surgery GPs using Mediform designed by Dr Niall Maguire, we can export the data to the iPCRN for analysis. Same as export for Atrial Fibrillation and Diabetes to iPCRN
9. Query plus improvements
 - a) Easier to find analyses in the include/exclude list
 - b) Grouped analyses can now be ordered per users wish so the excel output has the correct anal first (=100% in calculations)
