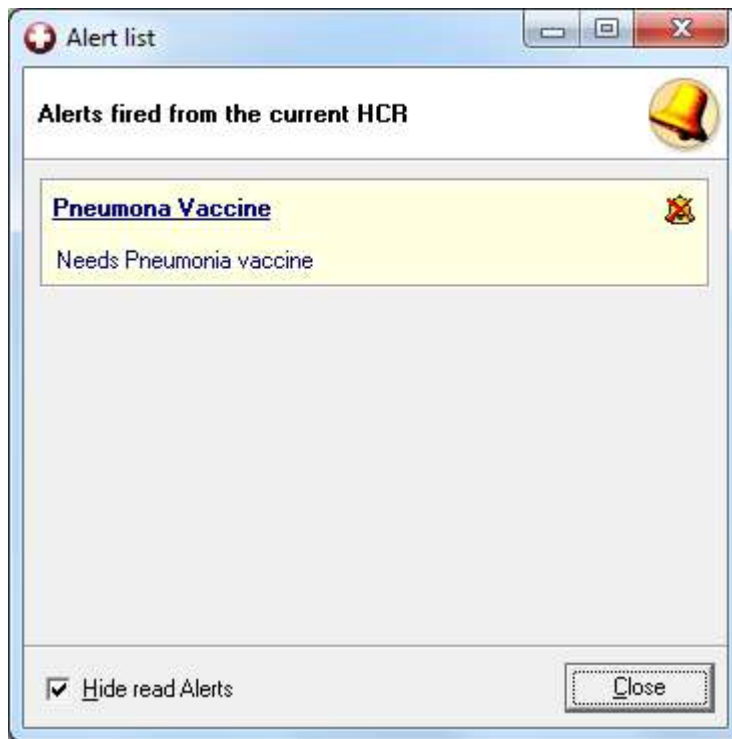

It is set up in the configuration tool and should look like this.

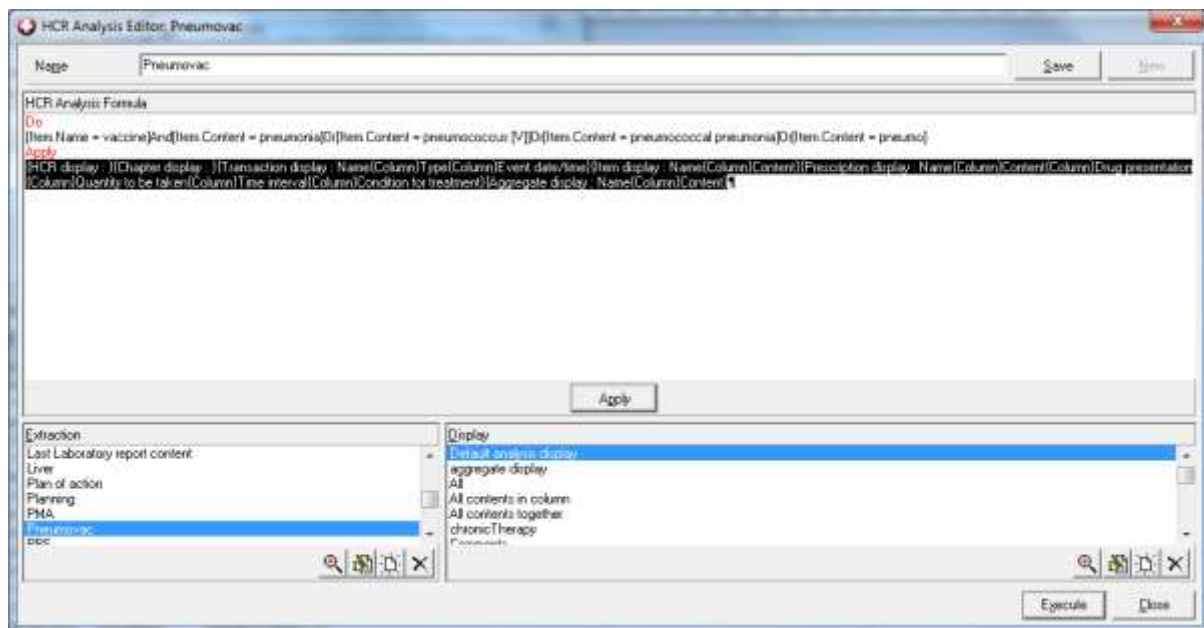

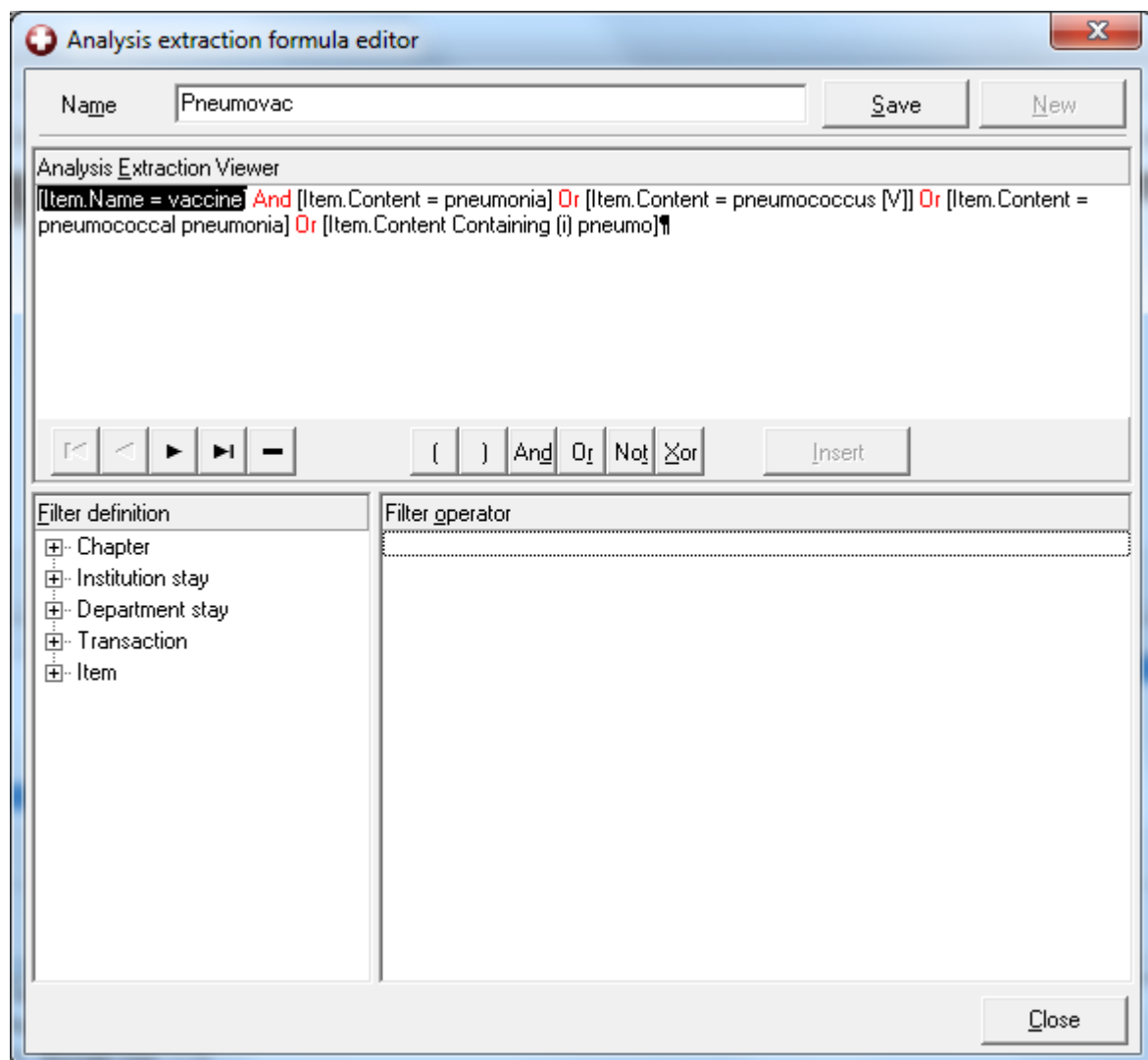

The pneumovac search referred to has to be in the HCR analysis and as its not currently a standard one you will have to write it your self. To do this in Health One with a patient file open create a HCR analysis like this
