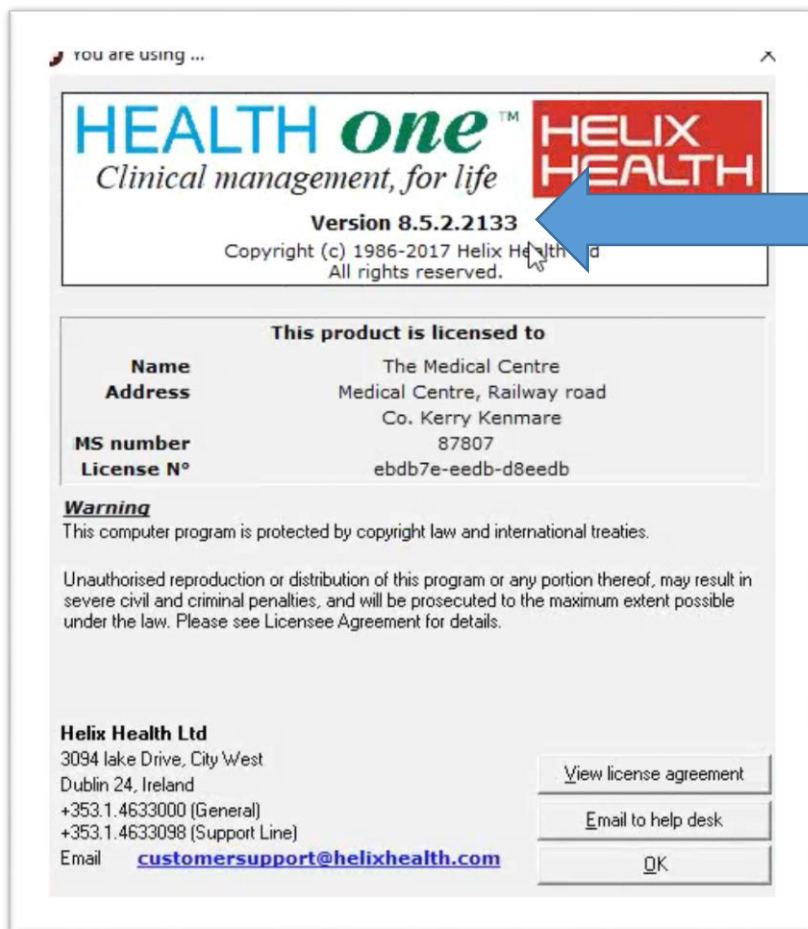

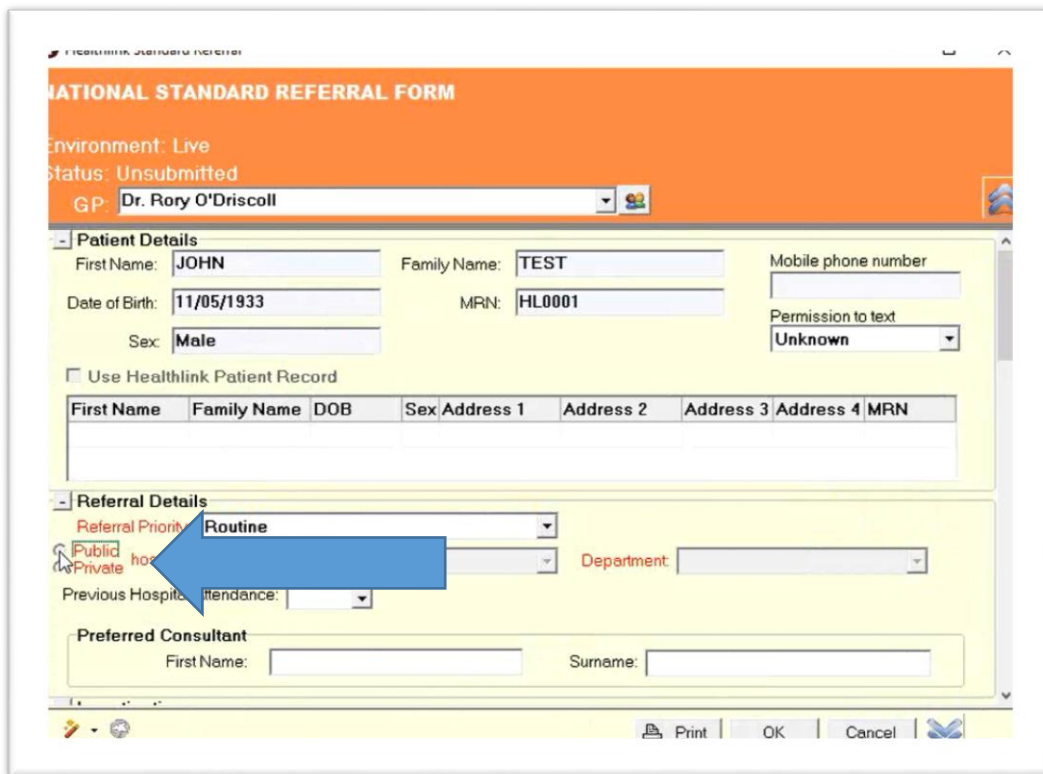

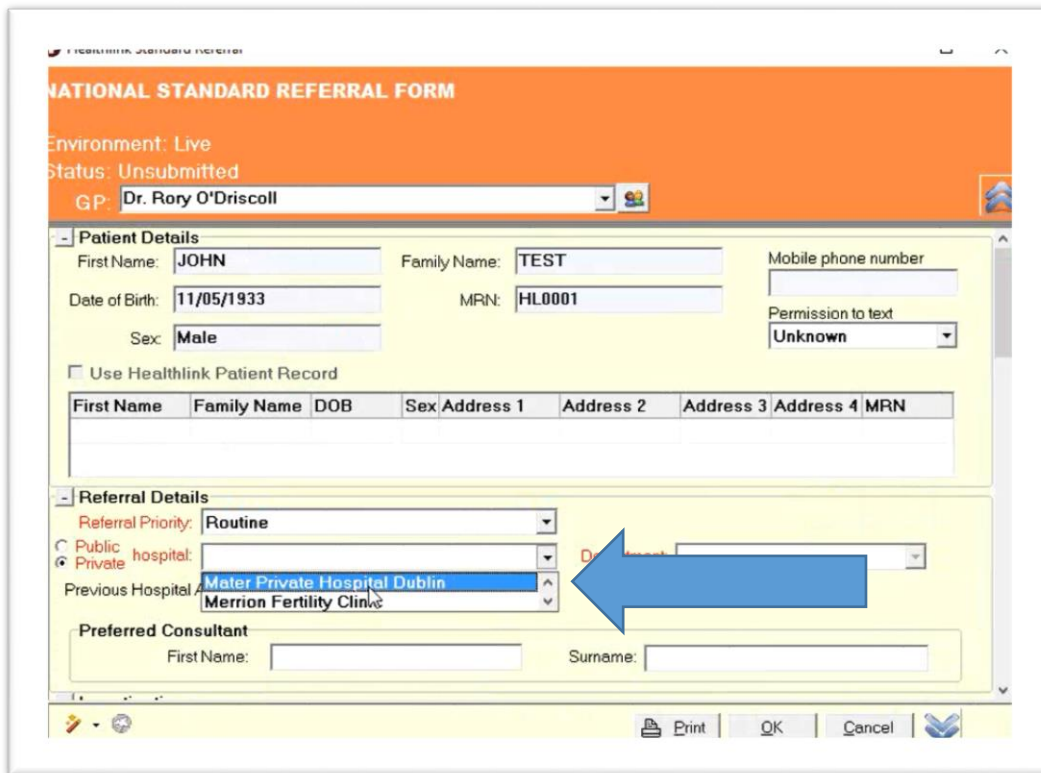
Electronic Referrals

This first section of this update is in relation to the Electronic Referrals from the private hospitals and Alliance in Health One.

Firstly we will look at the Standard Referral in this version. There is now the possibility to refer to the public or private hospitals by choosing from the options available when the referral form opens.



When you choose 'private hospital' there are only a couple of options available to choose from but Healthlink will update this as time goes on.

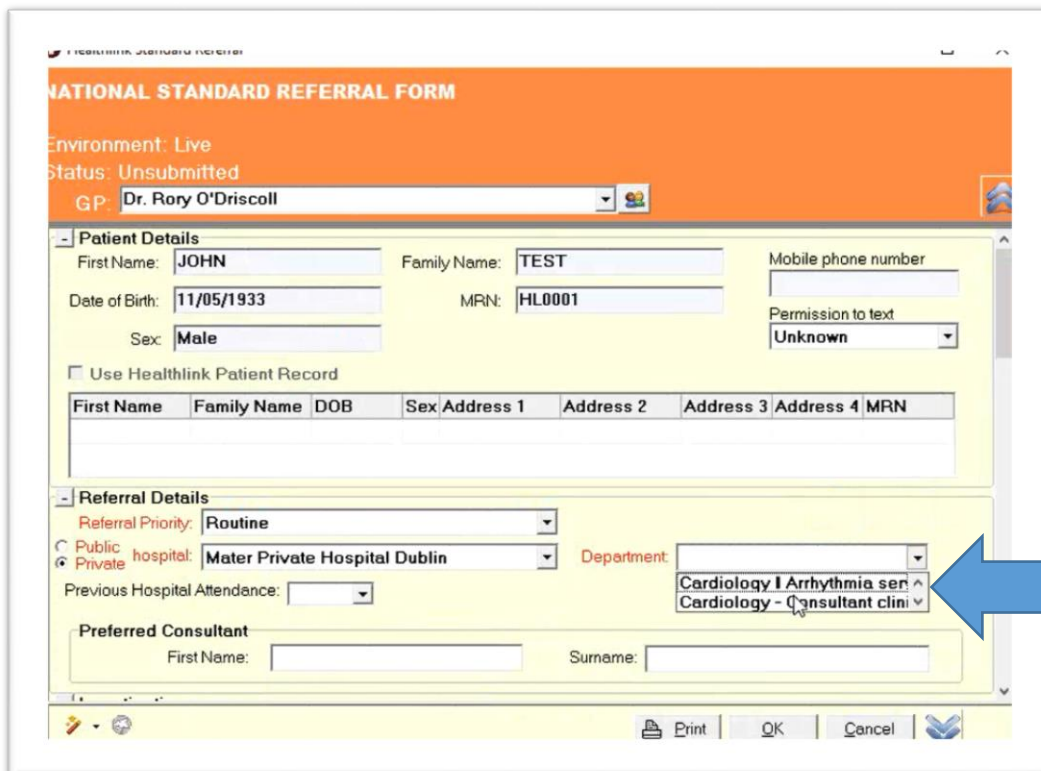

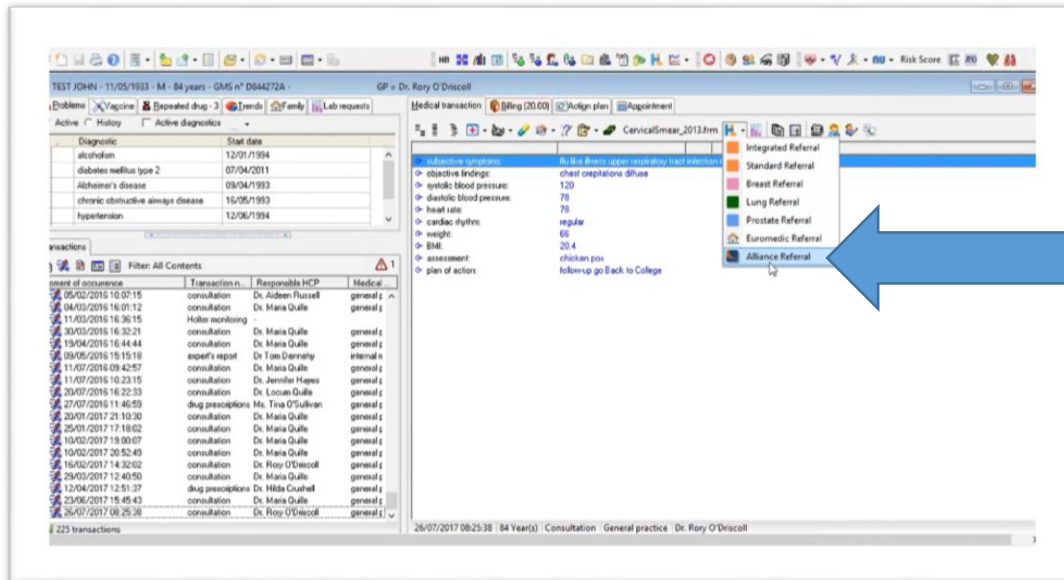

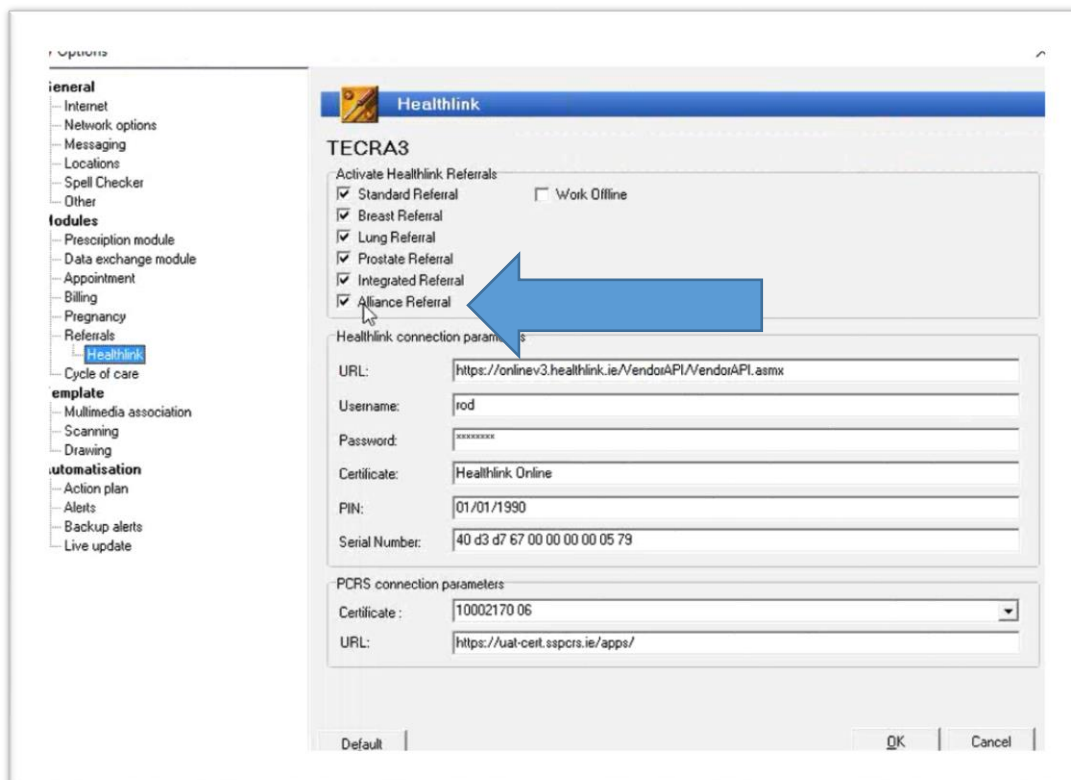

Alliance Referral

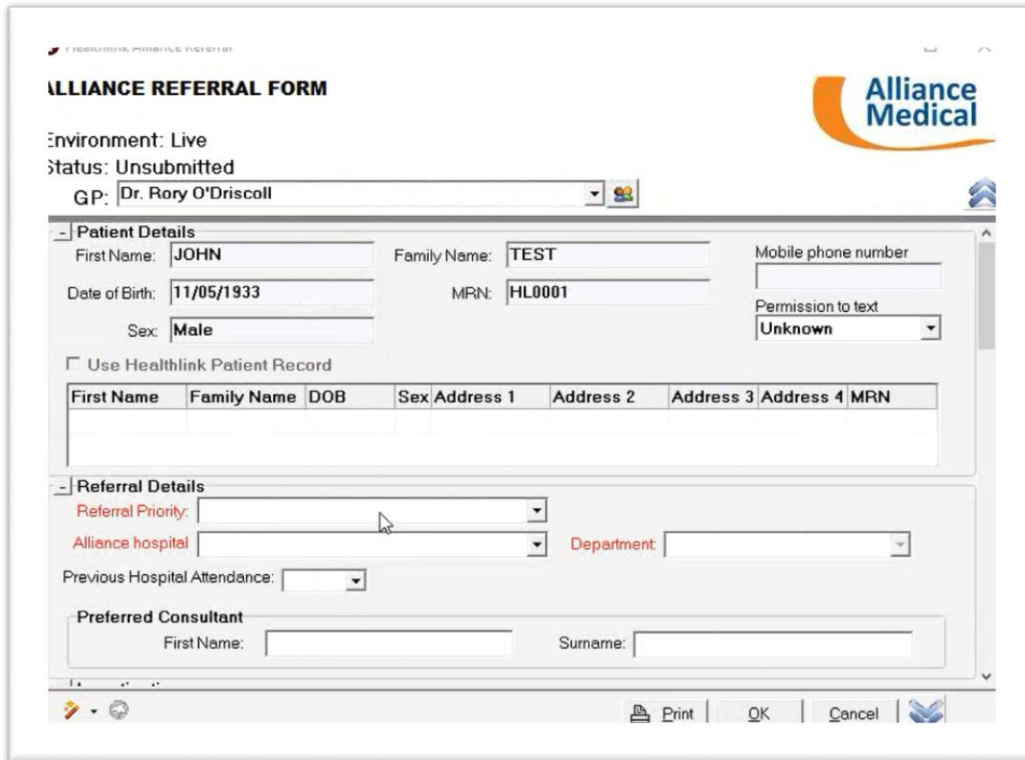
There is a new option in the drop down list for Alliance Referrals.



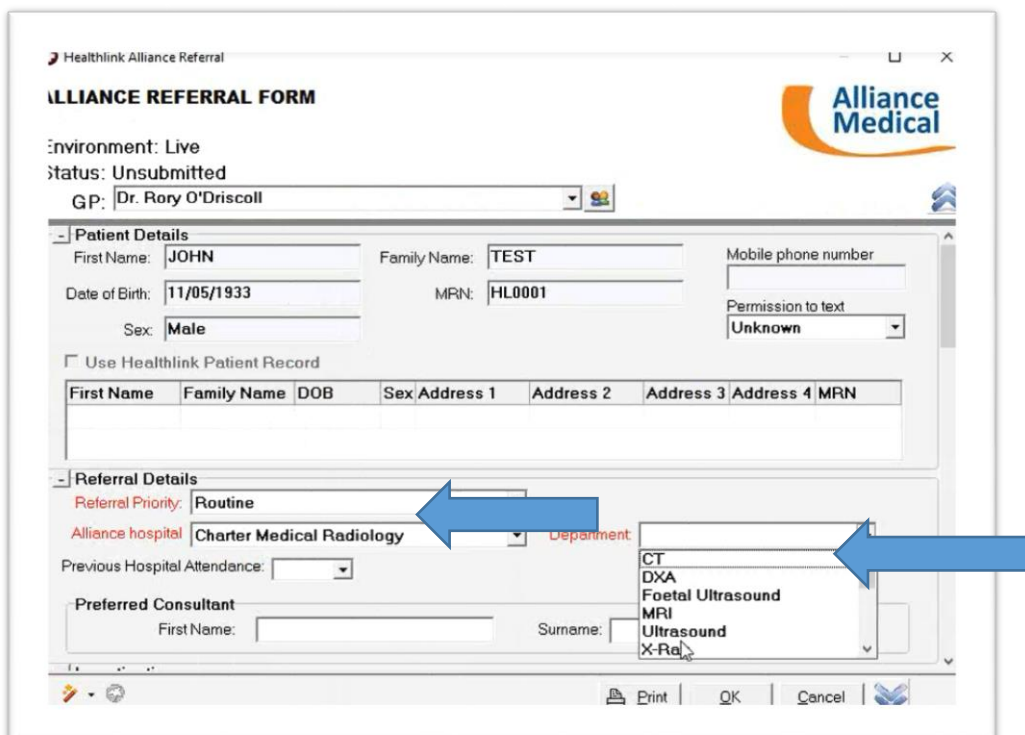
This is currently only available for X-Ray's/MRI's to private hospitals and it is turned on by default but you have the option to activate or de-activate it from 'Tools'- 'Options'- 'Healthlink' and you can tick the box or untick depending on your preference.



To send an Alliance Referral, choose the option from the drop down list as usual and the Alliance Referral form will be displayed

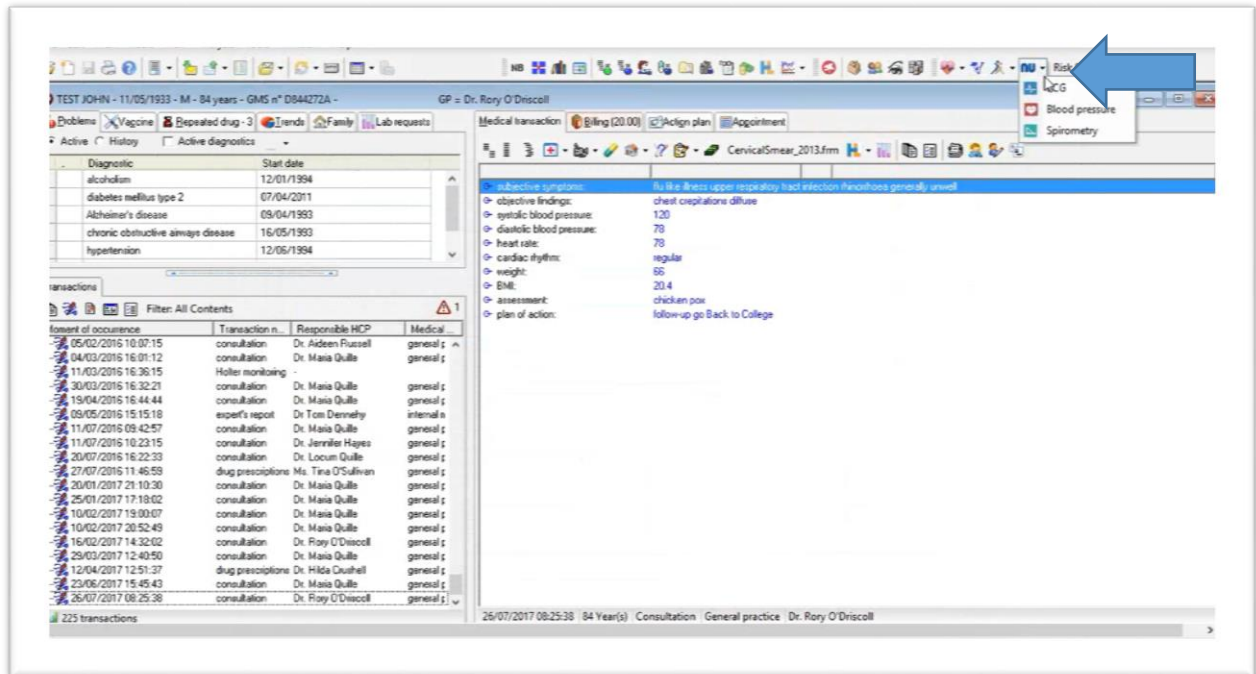


The form will be populated with the patient data and you will populate any of the fields required by choosing from the drop down options available.



External Devices

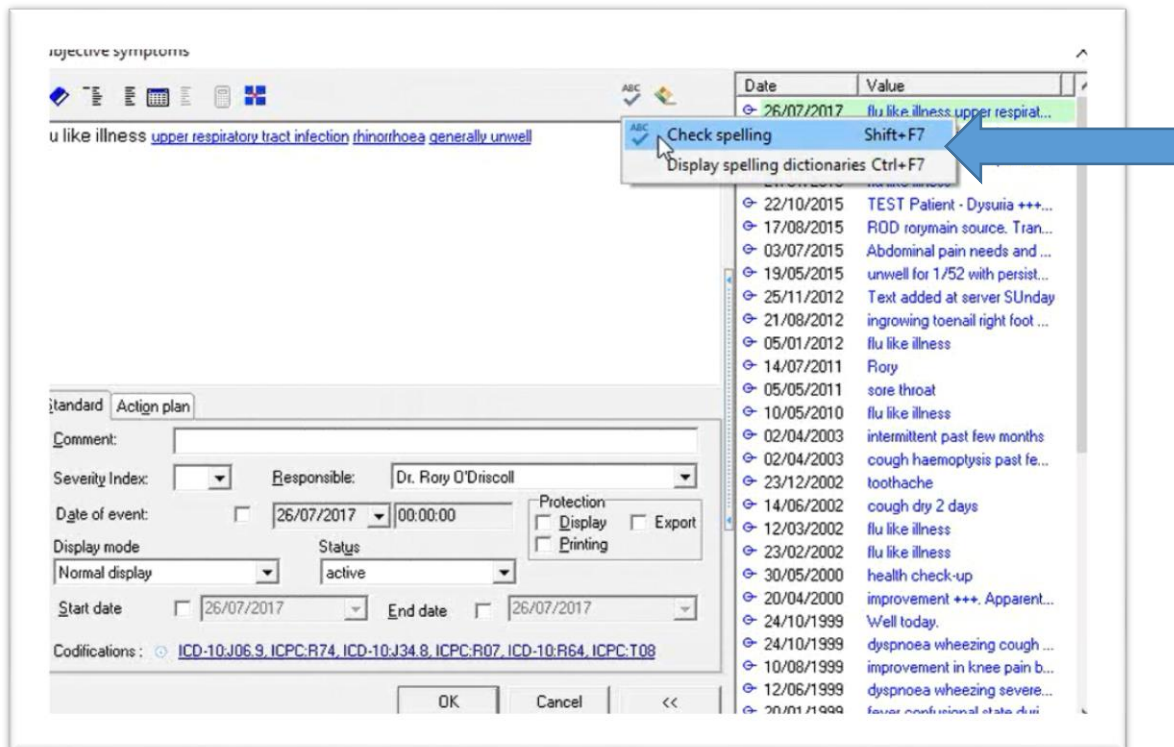
When in the patient file, there is now a new external device option to choose from called 'Nu-Med'.



This icon will only appear if the Nu-Med software is installed and is not fully operational yet and there will be further updates on this in a later release.

Spell Checker

This release has a minor change to the spell checker. In each item now, you will find a 'spell checker button' . This button allows you to check the spelling and display the dictionaries by clicking on the button and choosing from the drop-down menu. This was available in the earlier version but the only way to access it was to press Shift+F7 or Ctrl+F7 to bring up the dictionaries but it's now easily available by clicking the button.

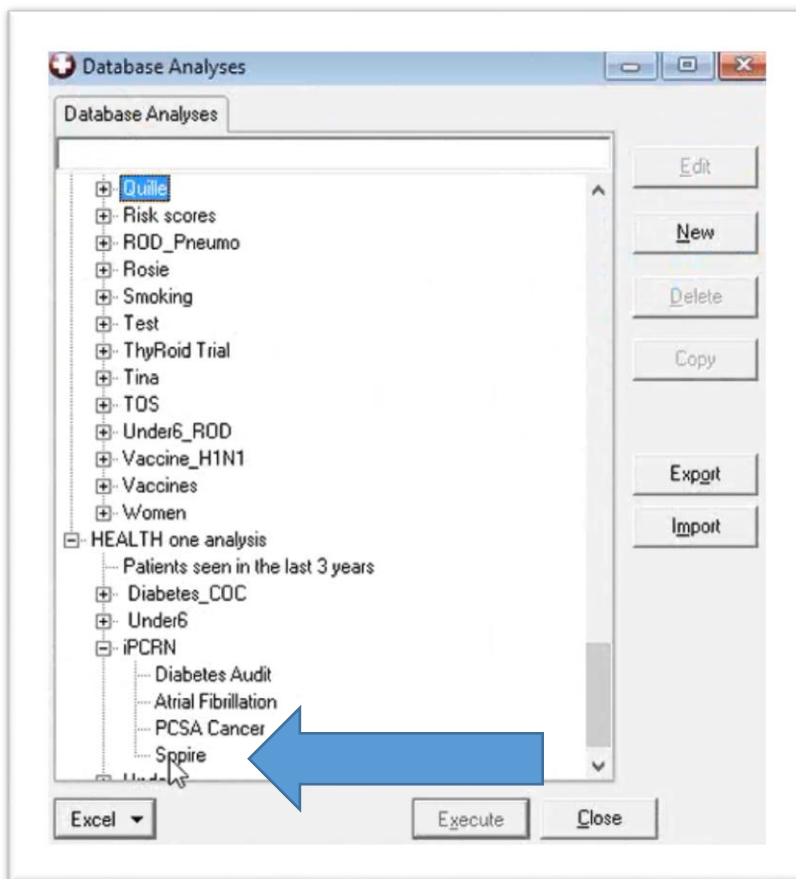


SPPIRE

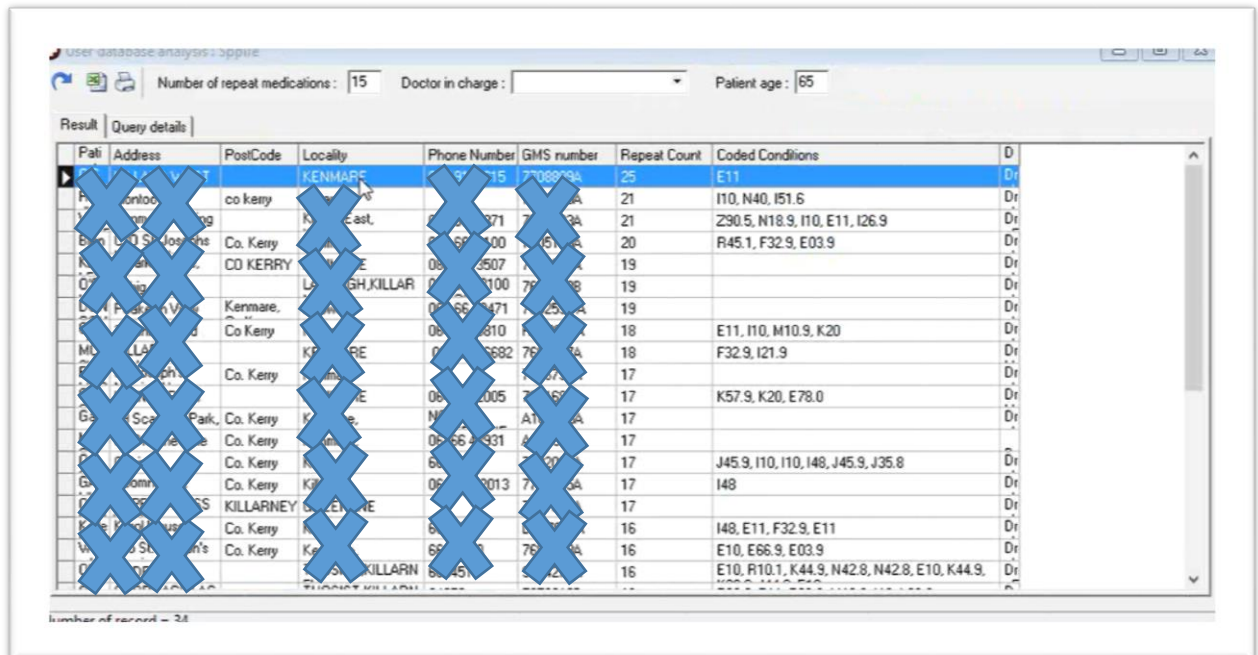
Also in this version is a development designed specifically for the IPCRN and the RCSI who are doing a project called SPPIRE which stands for the following:

(Supporting Prescribing in older patients with multimorbidity and significant Polypharmacy in primary care: a cluster randomised control trial)

To access the SPPIRE go to 'Tools'-'Analysis'-'Database Analysis'-and Under 'Health One Analysis' choose 'SPPIRE'.



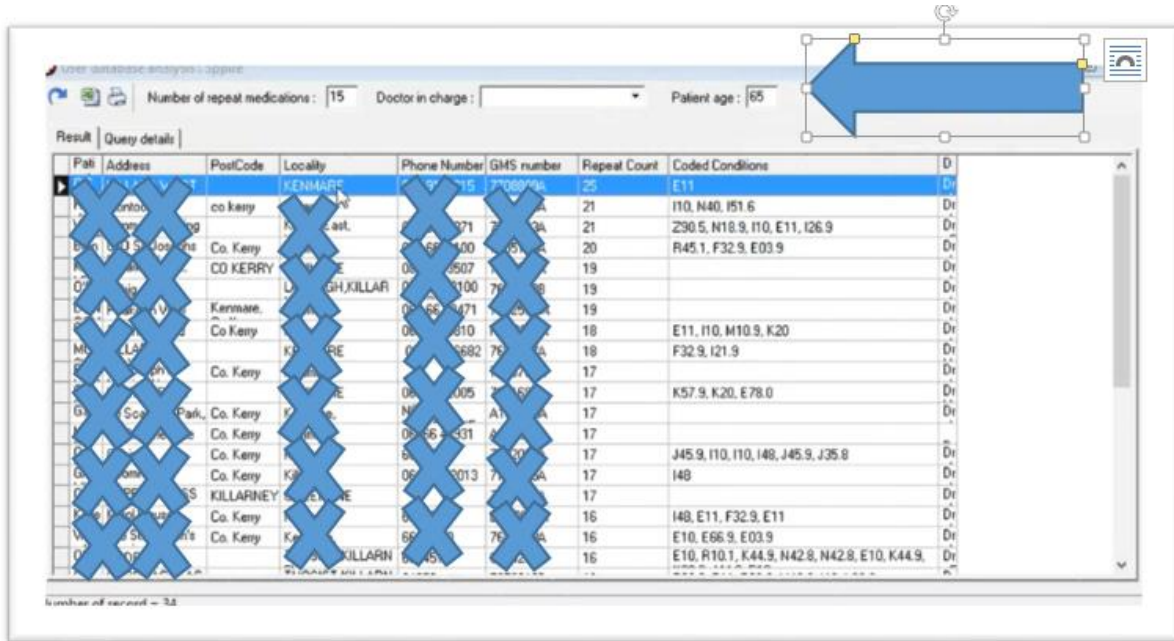
Click 'Execute' to run the report. You will get a result similar to the following:

It will display patient name/address/postcode/locality/phone number/GMS number/Repeat Count and Condition Count.

The idea is to give a list of all patients who have more than '15' repeat medications and for patients over the age of '65'. The report is sorted in reverse order by the number of repeats in the 'repeat count' field. At the top you have the option to change the filters to any number of repeats you like, you can also choose by 'doctor' in the practice by choosing from the drop down option 'doctor in charge' which is taken from the item 'doctor in charge' and you can change the patient age to suit your requirements.

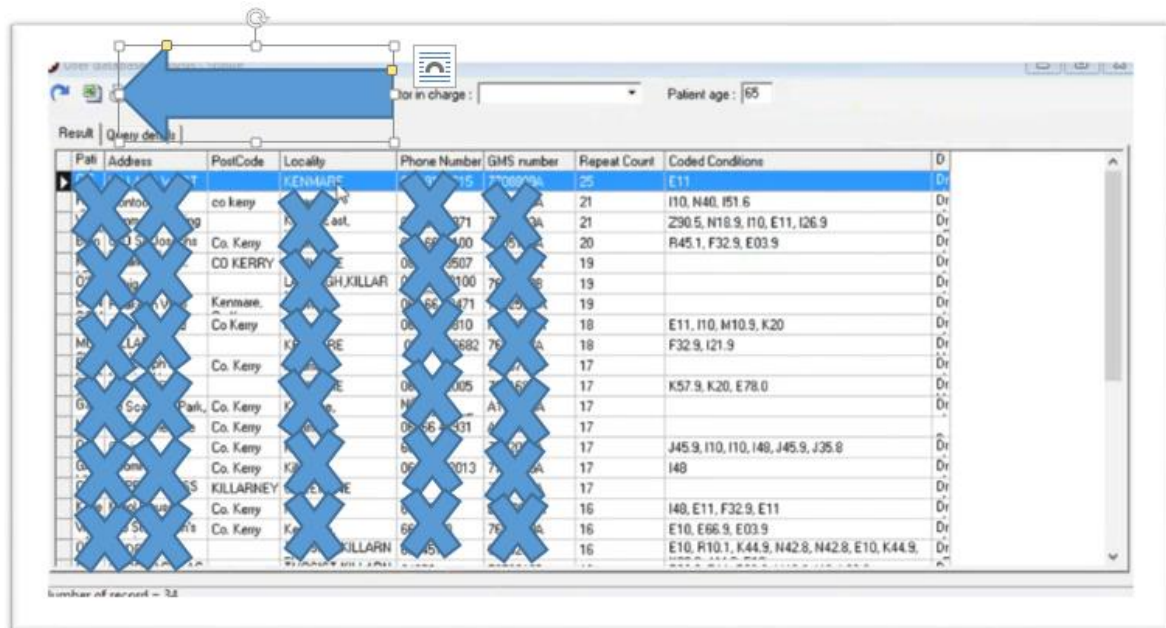

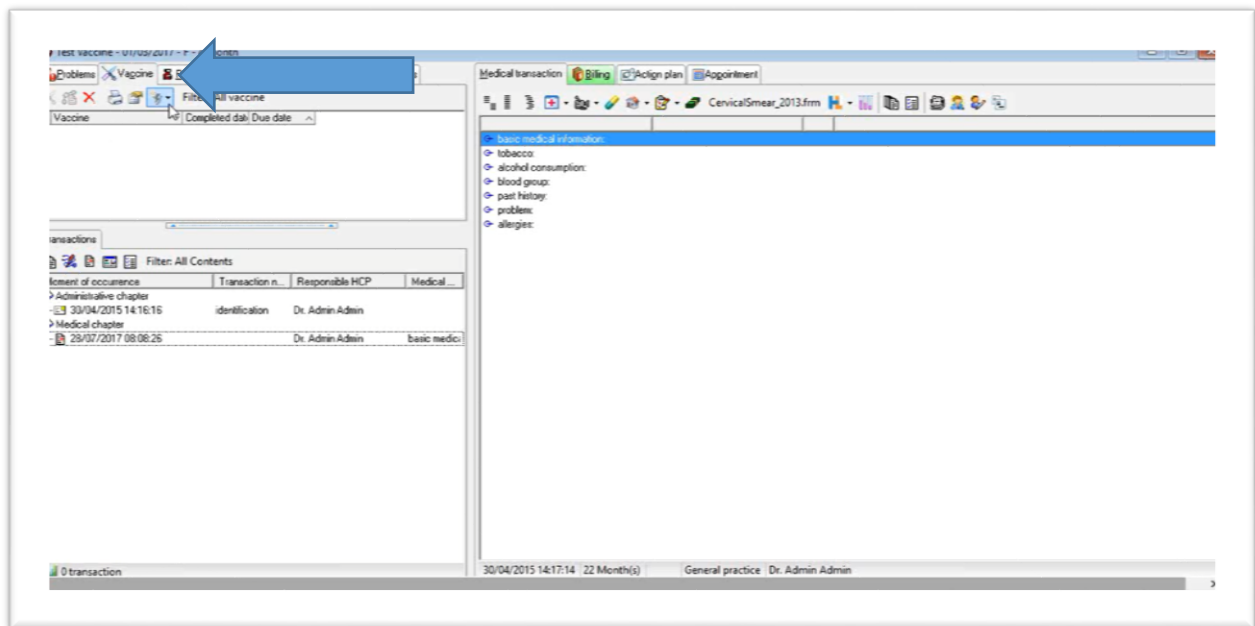

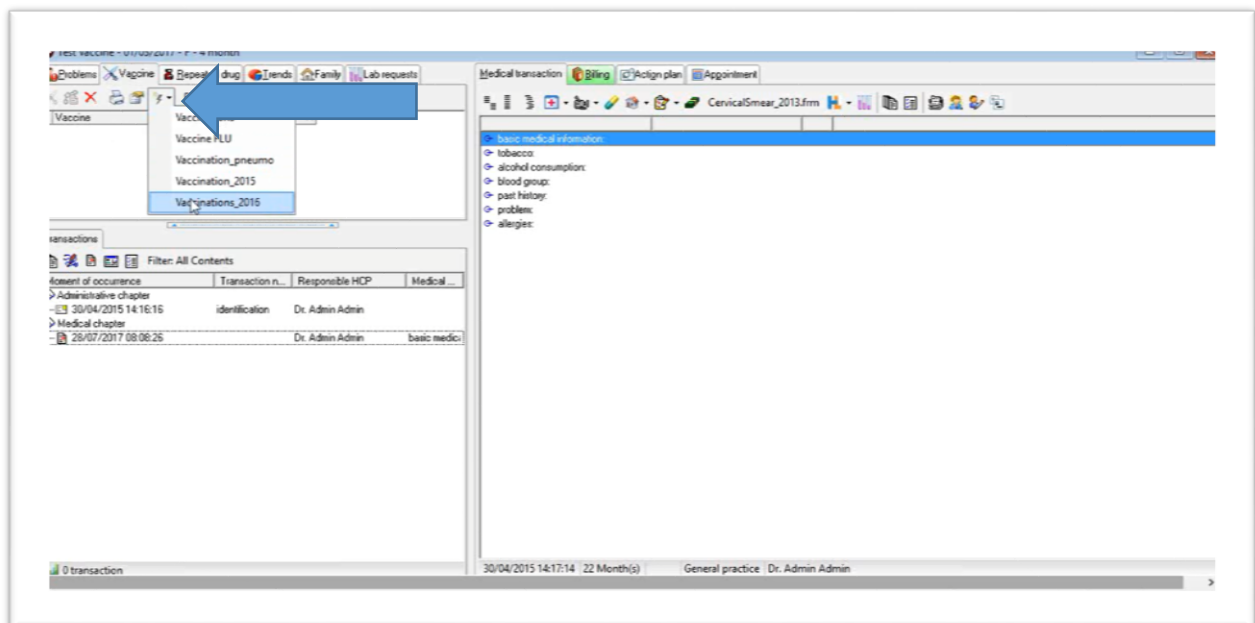
Vaccine

Some new functions have been added to Vaccines to allow you to change the batch and expiry 'on the fly' and there has also been a counter added to count down the vaccines you have available.

Go to a patient file and click on the 'Vaccine' tab

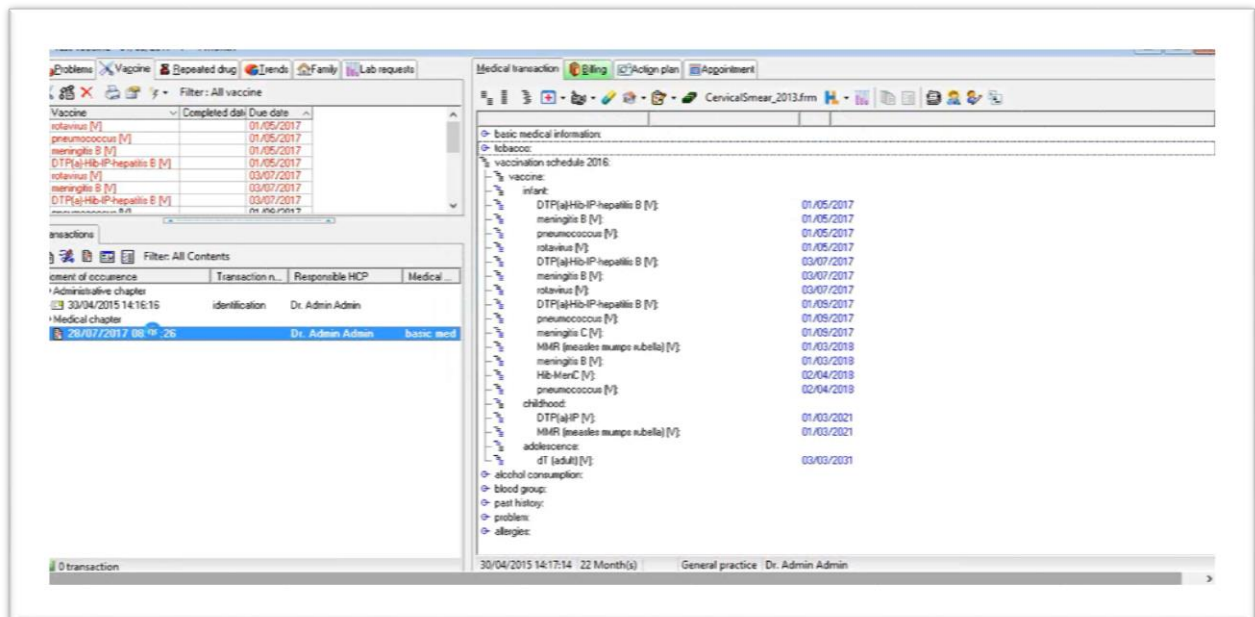


Firstly, just to note you can insert the 'vaccine schedule' by clicking on the down arrow and choosing the latest schedule from the list.

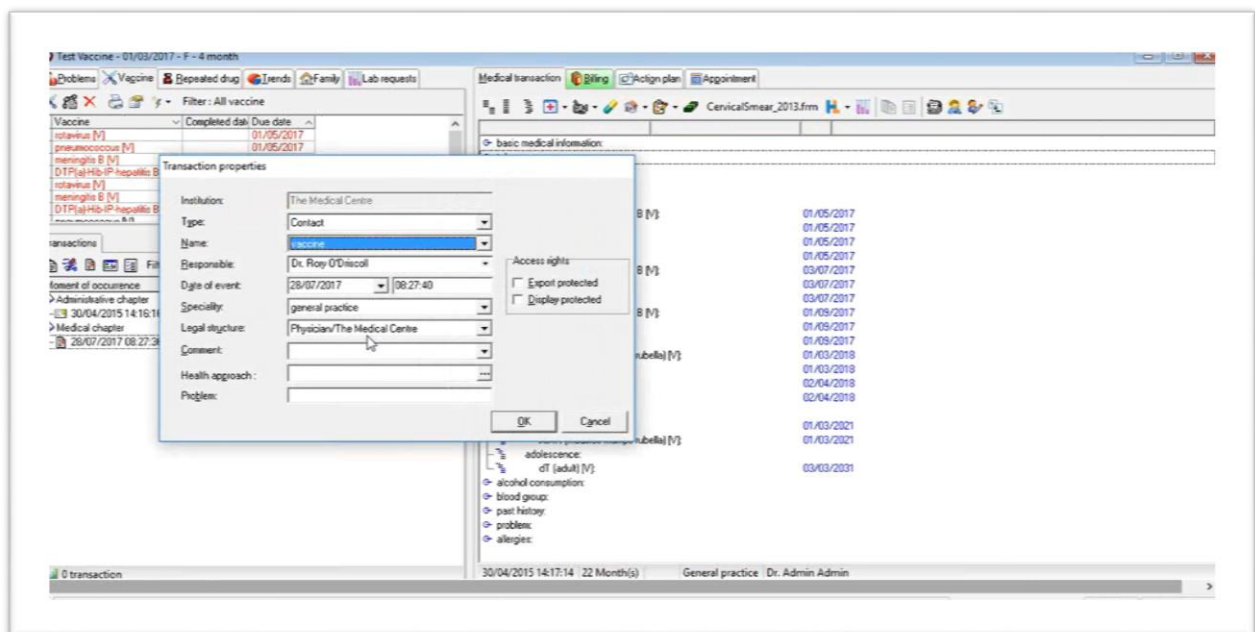


This immediately puts the vaccine schedule into the patients file.

You have now got your vaccine schedule and it has been added to the vaccine tab.

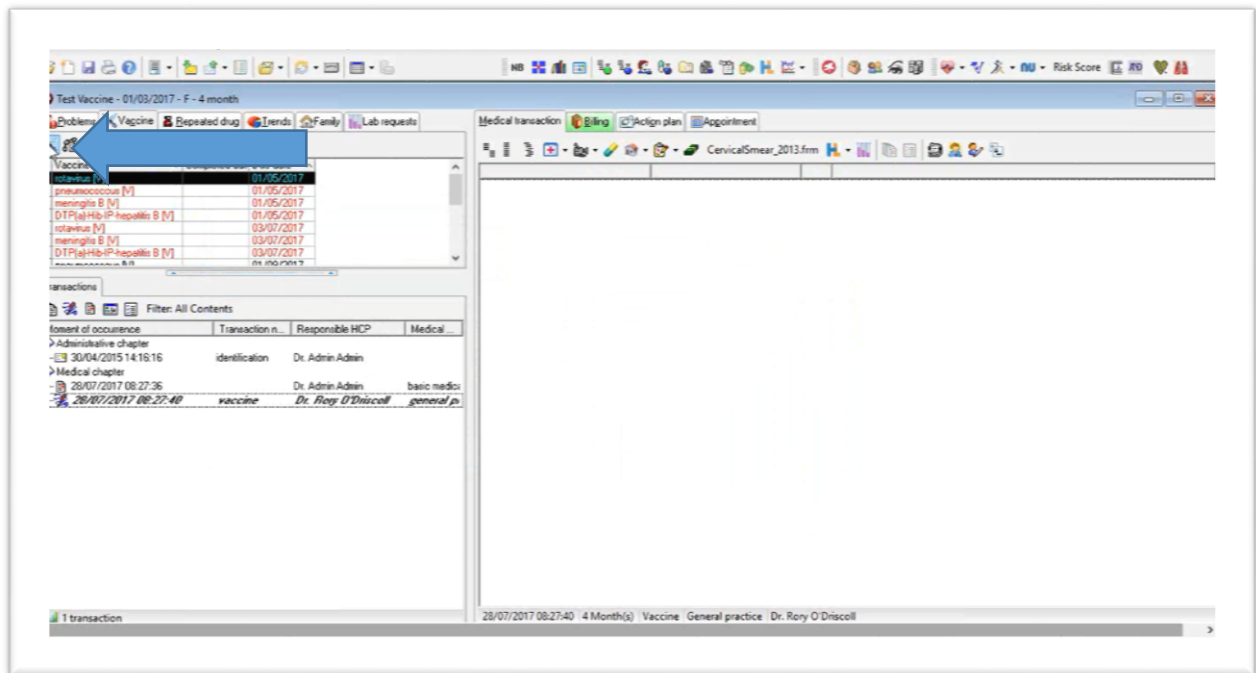


To administer the vaccine, first do a new consultation called 'vaccine'

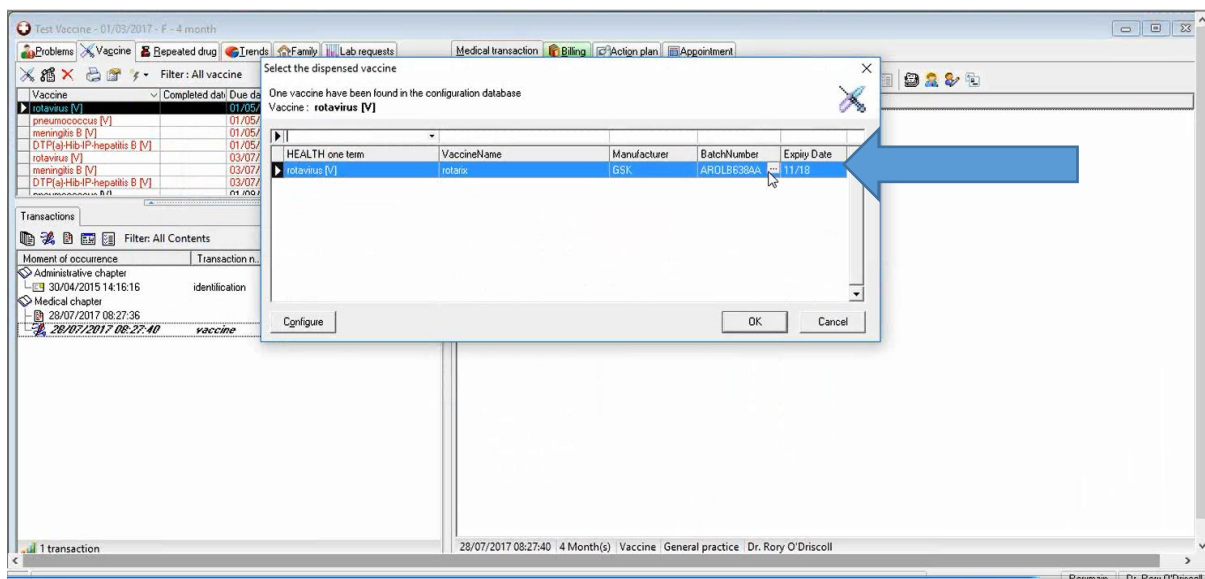


Highlight the vaccine you wish to administer from the list and click the 'dispense vaccine' button.

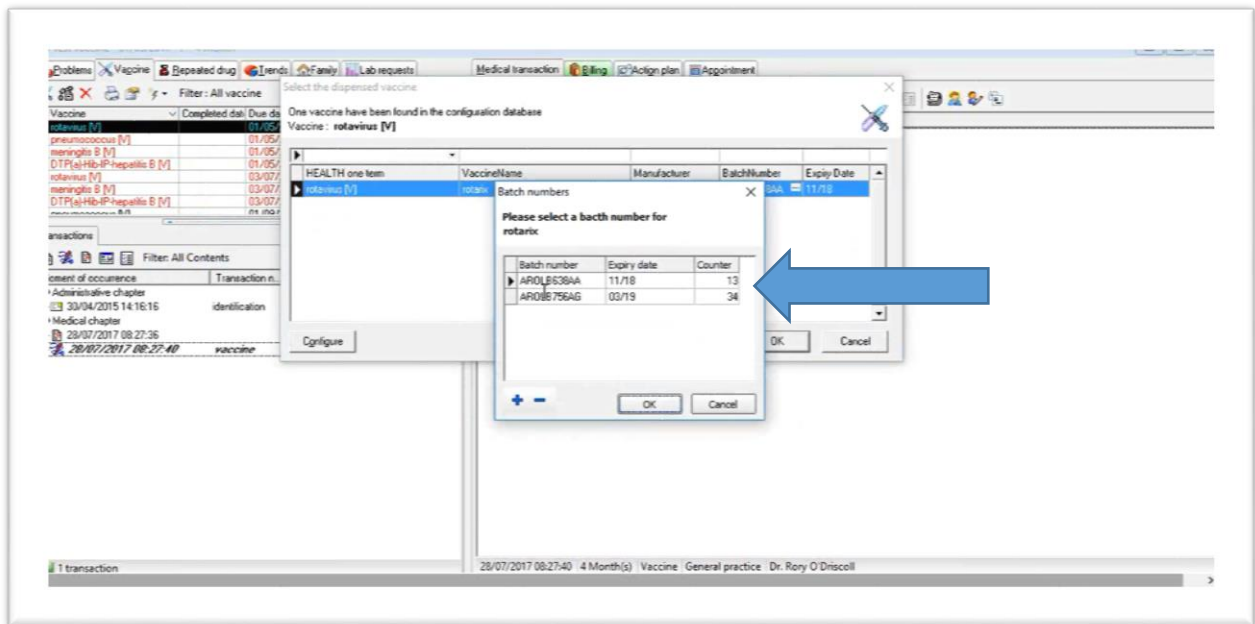




In this version you can change the batch number and expiry date from here



In this example, if you have a Rotavirus and you click 'ok' you will be presented with a choice of batch numbers. From here you can add several batch numbers by clicking on the blue arrow at the bottom, and inserting the batch numbers, expiry dates and number of vaccines you have. Health One will count down as you use the vaccines.



Once you have chosen the batch and clicked 'ok', the completed date will be populated as before.
